

JUNIOR SKETCHBOOK ASSIGNMENTS

1. Draw a piece of fruit such as an apple or orange. On one piece of paper, draw it whole, then sliced vertically or crosswise, with seeds or with a bite out of it. Use several different views.
2. Draw a twig in detail.
3. Draw a friend or a family member at the workplace (even if it is doing dishes at home.)
4. Do a self portrait in the pointillist (stippling / dots) technique with markers.
5. Select a small corner of the room and do a perspective line drawing of it.
6. Draw your own hand holding something using a felt tipped marker pen. Use the cross hatching technique to show shadows.
7. Use a fine line marker to draw the inside of your locker, or your closet or your room.
8. With coloured pencil, draw something small and personal such as a wallet and cards, contents of purse or keys. Include details and value.
9. Draw a series of eyes or noses or mouths in as many different ways as you can think of.
10. Pick a tool such as an adjustable wrench, corkscrew etc (it must have details) and draw this tool in ink, show a range of values.
