GRADE 11 VISUAL ART SKETCHBOOK ASSIGNMENTS

- 1. Draw a pop can or a soup can (w/o the label) using pencil. Draw it as if it is either melting or exploding.
- 2. Create your own advertisement for an event or product. Pay attention to the layout, typography (font) and imaging in your work. You may do this digitally or by hand, but it should be included in your iwb.
- 3. Create a line or colour abstract drawing based on listening to a piece of music. Make sure to submit a copy of the song and lyrics along with your sketchbook.
- 4. Draw an object or take a photograph of an object as it is reflected on a curved surface (bumper, spoon, instrument etc.).
- 5. Draw a bow from a present in detail.
- 6. Using a mirror, draw the image of your own face using one continuous contour line. If no mirror is available, use the picture on your student card or another photograph of yourself.
- 7. Draw a realistic self-portrait that reflects your personality.
- 8. Draw the inside of your own head. Fill the whole page. Do <u>not</u> draw your brain or your head. Be imaginative and conceptual. What are you like? Are you: colourful? plain,? Disorganized? Energetic? soft,?sharp,? focused? musical? Express what is on your mind visually.
- 9. Create your own logo that symbolized YOU. Research other logos and think about how these symbols have come to represent companies. (eg. Nike swoosh, Mercedes symbol, Peace sign) How could you create a design so powerful, that words are not needed.
- 10. Draw a landscape scene either from going outside directly or look out a window. Try to capture the mood or weather in your drawing. This may be done in either coloured pencil or black and white.
