

PHOTOSHOP REFRESHER AND SHORTCUTS

CMYK = Cyan, Magenta Yellow Black- this is the colour mode for print documents or photographs

RGB = Red Green Blue- This is the colour mode for screen (tv, web, monitors etc)

Resolution = how many pixel make up an image. The larger the amount of pixels, the higher the resolution. For web, the highest resolution you should use is 72 ppi (pixels per inch)
For print, you should use a minimum of 300 ppi (pixels per inch)
The higher the number of pixels, the more space is required to store the image.

Command “N”= the shortcut to open a new file on photoshop

The letter next to each tool will tell you which keyboard shortcut will activate that tool.

“v”= move or pick tool

“w” is the quick selection or magic wand

Command “d” gets rid of the “marching ants” marqee

Command “z” undo the last the action that you did. If you want to undo more than one action, you can either go to Edit>Undo and repeat it, or you can go to Windows>History and then undo the steps you’ve

Command delete = Background Fill
