

VISUAL ART SUPPLY LIST

Most of the materials are provided by the Art Department, however there are some everyday personal items that students are to bring to class each day. The following is a list of those items.

Material Requirements:

In addition, students are required to bring the following supplies:

1. 2 pieces of heavy Bristol board or cardboard which will be used to make a portfolio.
2. A set of coloured pencils. (24 pencils at least) Prismacolor if possible.
3. Pencils for drawing. Preferably **B** pencils for drawing, **2B-6B** pencils are recommended. Mechanical pencils are **not** recommended.
4. A 30cm clear plastic ruler. It is important that the ruler is transparent.
5. A personal pencil sharpener with a container for shavings.
6. 2 fine black marker pens. Pilot fineliner is recommended.
7. An “inspiration file” is recommended. This is a collection of pictures, photographs, images and materials that interest you and may give ideas later for your work.
8. Keep an old shirt in your locker, you may need it occasionally in the studio.

Occasionally I will ask students to bring props and other items to the studio.

It is essential that students come to each class prepared with their equipment and an open mind. Students who come unprepared on more than one occasion may be asked to work outside the studio until they come with the proper equipment.
